SPURTABILITY chased the pace, angled off the rail into the turn then edged past the leader late in the stretch under a steady drive. PROUD JUSTICE stalked the pace, angled three wide into the turn then led in the stretch but yielded late. STORM CELLAR tracked the pace from the inside, stayed on the rail into the turn and steadied and checked late stretch while in tight through the final furlong. SCHMOOPY HANG ON lunged at the start, swung widest into the lane then rallied in the stretch but was too late. MR. EDDIE R rushed up early to set the pace, angled off the rail into the turn then gave way late in the stretch. UNBRIDLED ZIP was unhurried early, angled three wide into the turn with no rally. THINK ABOUT YOU broke slow from the gate, angled off the rail into the turn with a belated gain. COMIC BOOK HERO showed brief speed then retreated. THE KING STINGER was always outrun. PHILCO was through after a half.
