WALKINSIS'S SHADOW mid pack and inside, came through inside of rival into the stretch, angled out for clear racing room, closed willingly and hung late. ANNIE'S ARROW mid pack and between rivals, angled out to loop four wide through the turn, fanned widest into the stretch and got up for the show. SHEZ ONA CRUSADE stalked the early pace outside, moved up to challenge for and gain a short lead into the stretch, then weakened the final furlong. IT'S RAINING GOLD lunged at the start, closed willingly on the rail. LAVOLTA ran evenly. RUNAWAY LAUNCH was no factor. WALLSTREET SPIDER was never involved. BONNY LADY set the early pace off the rail and faded after a half. NO MORE BETS well placed and outside, was through after a half.
