Footnotes

HIGHER LOGIC tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn then took over command and drew off late in the stretch under a steady drive. BELLAROSA INDY set the pace early, while on the inside into the turn and faltered late in the stretch while no match for the winner. LIBERTELANE BLUFF was unhurried early, swung into the six path in the turn and moved up in the stretch drive. C J'S SUNRISE angled into the five path in the turn and improved position. UPTOWN JUSTICE angled into the five path in the turn and was empty in the stretch. SHORT AND SASSY was done early. THETEFLOWARRIOR was through after a half. MAYBEMAYBENOT had brief speed then folded up. WEE BIT CITY was always outrun. GOTTA LUV IT broke down.
