LAIRD set the pace early from the inside, angled off the rail into the turn then drew off in the stretch under a steady drive. SKY AND ELI chased the pace early from the four path, stayed in the four path in the turn but was no match for the winner in the stretch drive. IAIN'TMADATCHA was unhurried early, swung widest into the lane and moved up. WALLSTREET CHARLIE tracked the pace from the three path early, stayed in the three path in the turn with no late rally. ITSA HOLIDAY raced up close early while on the rail into the turn and faded late. HONKY TONK GOLD angled into the three path in the turn while no threat. ROLLINONWALLSTREET angled into the four path in the turn while no factor. JACKS ARE LUCKY had brief speed then retreated. SIR DAKOTA stumbled at the start then was rushed up and eventually spent. IRON HOOF had early speed then folded up.
