UNLOOSENED BIT was well placed early, angled four wide into the turns then edged away late in the stretch under a steady drive. TYPHOONIGATOR set the pace early from the inside, stayed on the rail into the far turn and yielded late in the stretch. CHIS MAGIC stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn while making a bid but weakened late in the stretch. LOVE THIS TRICK raced up close early, angled off the rail into the far turn and faded late. MORO PROSPECTOR pressed the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn but couldn't sustain the bid in the stretch run. SPOT RUN was settled off the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and was tired in the lane. OAK RICH steadied repeatedly throughout. CLASSIC ORDER was never involved.
