### Footnotes

PACIFIC DANGER steadied into the first turn and chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn then made a bid in the stretch while drifting in and drove past the leader to clear the field late. SANDBAGGEN was unhurried early, angled into the three path in the far turn and was gaining late in the stretch run. DELVIN'S A HATER stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn then drifted out in the stretch and steadied slightly while making a bid and hung in the final stages. FLORIDA BLACK TIE was far back early, angled into the three path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch drive. AMRAM set the pace early then backed off the lead, came again into the far turn while off the rail and gave way in the stretch. REGAL KING was pulled up and vanned off.
