NEED MONEY DAD well back and outside, angled in into the turn and moved up, angled back out to bid four wide into the stretch, then made a steady gain and drew off under steady pressure. WALLSTREET CHARLIE sprinted to a clear lead soon after the start, increased his margin, then could not go with the winner the final furlong, stayed on to hold the place safe. TWINKLES MAGIC well placed and outside, ran evenly and lacked the needed late kick. SPURTABILITY tracked the pace inside and had a mild stretch gain to hold position. MOONSHINE STILL improved his position. TEE'S PROSPECT showed little, outside. TENMOR was never involved. WAKI PASSAGE well placed inside, was through after a half.
