CHASING LIBERTY void of speed and inside, angled out through the second turn to bid four wide into the stretch, drifted in through the lane and edged clear late. MAID TO A TEE bumped by a rival at the start, tracked the early pace four wide, took command through the second turn, gained a clear lead, then was outfinished in the late going. J W'S LAST DANCE four wide through the first turn, was well back and outside, bid on the same path into the stretch, then made a steady gain but could not threaten the top two. P. T. SHIC well back and inside, steadied into the second turn for racing room, came through inside of rivals into the stretch, then rallied up for a share. MISS CHATTERBOX tracked the early pace from between rivals, angled out into the second turn, dueled, weakened in the drive. TOO POCKETS FULL tracked the pace inside, stopped. DUNKIRK NATIVE broke out and bumped a rival at the start, sprinted to a clear lead, dueled through the second turn, faltered in the drive.
