### Footnotes

SPOKEN WORD rated back inside, pulled to contention into the second turn, gained a short lead into the stretch, dueled with MADALIN NICOLE through the lane and prevailed. MADALIN NICOLE stalked the early pace outside, moved up to challenge through the second turn, dueled with the winner through the lane and was outfinished. STORM N ROSIE LACE mid pack and off the rail, angled in into the second turn, moved up on the rail, came through inside of rivals into the stretch, then closed willingly to have a mild gain while no threat to the top two. INDEMAND well back and off the rail, looped rivals three wide through the turn, steadied hard mid way of the turn off a rivals heels, then closed willingly through the lane to gain a share. ARKANSAS PAT sprinted to the lead from the gate while drifting out, dropped back through the backstretch, then came again to gain a striking position through the second turn and could not gain the final furlong. SWEET NANAPUDDIN passed tiring rivals. MIDNIGHT KUGER showed little. WILMINGTON gained a striking position through the second turn and faltered. WHITE SPIKE was outrun. STELLAR STAR was pulled up and vanned off.
