LIEPERS FORK saved ground while moving up through the turn, continued to rally in the lane while angling outside his entymate leaving the eighth marker to collar that one and was moving clear late. LTN. LARRY showed good speed to move to the inside and establish the pace on a short clear lead then could not hold off his entymate in the late going. DOC'S AVENGER tracked the pace along the inside while never far back but could not go with the top pair in the final furlong. H POTTER was very reluctant to load, once in he was shuffled back between rivals at the start, saved ground through the turn and moved up in the late going to just miss the show. HAMMER DOWN HANK was bumped as a rival forced his way out heading up the backstretch, raced three to four wide on the turn and lacked a final closing response. HEZA WILD GUY prompted the pace three wide to late in the turn and weakened. TEE PHONE HOME veered in sharply at the start to force H POTTER back, raced four to five wide on the turn and failed to seriously menace. EL ARRIERO forced his way to the outside heading up the backstretch to bump HAMMER DOWN HANK, angled in through the turn and tired. TRICON GOLD was void of any early speed. PHONAGHOST was with the early pace racing three wide and gave way through the turn.
