CITY PRAYER tracked the pace outside SEE YOU TRICKY, responded in the lane and was slowly edging clear late. SEE YOU TRICKY showed the most early speed to gain the inside, made the pace on a clear lead, resisted through midstretch but was worn down late. PURPLE VIOLETS moved up three wide through the turn, angled out into the lane and closed but could not reach the top ones. KATANA GIRL stalked the pace in reach along the inside but lacked a rally. CASEYS PRIDE checked off heels approaching the turn when in tight, angled out and moved up late. JEWEL IN THE HILLS settled outside, raced four wide through the turn and lacked a closing response. RIVA'S AFFAIR raced out from the rail and tired. STEPHIE'S GOLD tracked the pace outside and tired. IT'S NOT MY FAULT was four to five wide through the turn into the stretch and tired. LEADING PROSPECT broke inward then bobbed at the start then was always back while five wide.
