PRESIDENTIAL BALL set the early pace on the rail, shook off multiple challenges and drew off by mid stretch, lasted inside. LITTLE GRINDSTONE trailed the field in the early going, gained contention into the stretch, closed fast in the late going and missed in the final strides. BLUE RYDER RED mid pack and off the rail, fanned four wide to bid into the stretch, then could not gain in the late going. KRISCROSSEDKRIS well back and outside, bid four wide and got up for a share. LIFT HIGH THE FLAG mid pack and inside, lacked the late response needed. SEATTLE BY THE SEA stalked the early pace three wide, dueled with a rival through the second turn, kept on and weakened in the late going outside. CHARLOTTETOWN tracked the early pace inside, headed the winner through the second turn, dueled, faded. STALWART KIDD was never involved. CRAFTY SCOUT four wide through the first turn, bid three wide through the second, stopped.
