Footnotes

SORREL'S SWITCH sent from the gate to gain a clear lead soon after the start, increased his margin through the turn, then lasted while all out. BENTLEY RED rushed up four wide, angled in slightly into the turn, bid three wide into the stretch, then made a steady gain and missed. HOLY ROMAN EMPIRE void of speed and inside, closed fast once in the lane, angled out late and got up for the show. WILDWOOD WINNER well back and outside, gained a striking position through the turn, bid widest into the stretch and flattened out. RED BOW TIE well back and on the rail, gained position through the turn and had no rally. JESS Z broke sharply from the gate and was rated on the rail, shortened stride in the lane and faltered. MITT ran evenly. SAHMMY FALLS stalked the early pace inside and was through after a half. MOUNT RAZMORE was never involved. SODA JERK well placed and between rivals, drifted out into the turn and faltered.
