DONE GONE set a well handled pace from the start, drew off in upper stretch and was kept to a drive in the end while clear. BIG REWARD chased the early pace while inside, saved ground on the turn then made a bid but was only second best in the end. FREE ENTRY rallied three wide on the turn making a bid then came up empty in late stretch. BUCKTOWN chased the early pace while two wide, was used up and faltered in the stretch drive. W. B. SMUDGE raced inside on the turn then was no factor in the stretch drive. CONSERVATIVE VALUE raced three wide on the turn and trailed throughout.
