MOLOKAI sprinted to clear lead from the gate, was challenged by WEST ON WALLSTREET entering the stretch, shook clear of that one, drew off, driving. SUNSET ARTISAN mid pack and outside, fanned four wide to bid into the stretch, altered out in mid stretch to avoid a fallen rival, got up for the place while no threat to the winner. LITTLEBALLOFFIRE stumbled at the start, then was void of speed and off the rail, fanned five wide to bid into the stretch, close willingly while no threat. SIR NASTY well place and three wide, bid on that path, altered out in mid stretch to avoid a fallen rival, then could not gain. SILVER SPUR well back and outside, circled the field through the turn, then lacked a rally. J T 'S COPPERLINE mid pack and between rivals, bid three wide, faded in the drive. WEST ON WALLSTREET broke down.
