DALAMAR chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn then took over command in the stretch, drew clear in the stretch and held sway in the final stages. CITOYEN STYLE set the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn then lost the lead in the stretch but came again late and did not have enough. MANA WINDS was well placed early, angled off the rail into the turn with some late gain in the stretch run. HALO CASPER was unhurried early, angled into the three path in the turn and flattened out late in the stretch. TRIMIT pressed the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and weakened late. LITTLE CHINO broke slowly at the start and moved up. RUSTY'S RED BOY was never a threat. TALBOT was done early. LINE I ONE was through after a half. PROPER LAD was never a factor.
