MORNING PATRICK well placed and three wide, moved up to bid just outside the pace setter, drifted in the lane under left hand urging, then straightened and got up in the final strides. DRAKE'S DANCER set the early pace inside, shook clear through the turn, then was outfinished in the final strides. LIL CON MAN well placed and four wide, angled in slightly through the turn to bid three wide into the stretch and flattened out. SHORT SALE well back and outside, moved up through the turn, fanned widest into the stretch and got up for a share. STREAK O GREY stalked the early pace outside, dropped back through the turn, angled out to bid four wide and ran evenly in the lane. DR. JASPER well placed and off the rail, steadily faded. GEORDIE ran evenly, inside. MORO GUSTO improved his position. MOROS LAUNCHER was never involved, inside. SOMETHING ALARMING was no factor, inside.
