GUAM TYPHOON stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn then rallied in the stretch and edged past the leader in the final stages. GRAND TRAVERSE dueled early, while on the inside into the turn then shook clear in the stretch but was caught late. BIRDIE BEATS PAR dueled early, angled off the rail into the turn and faltered late in the stretch run. GOOD LORD angled off the rail into the turn and moved up in the stretch drive. SPECTACULAR KID tracked the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and faded late in the stretch. PHAT DAY bobbed at the start and was done early.
