SYMPATHY ACT broke slowly from the gate and trailed the field early, angled off the rail into the turn then rallied in the stretch and drove past the leader in the final stages. SPEEDSTER pressed the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn then took over the lead in the stretch but yielded late in the drive. INNER TRUTH set the pace early, while on the inside into the turn and faltered late in the stretch run. THE LADY ISA CHAMP was unhurried early, swung into the six path in the turn and moved up in the stretch. POINT TO THE WILD angled into the five path in the turn and never menaced. FREAK OUT was through after a half. ON MY WAY HOME had early speed then folded up. MANNING MILLER was always outrun.
