PUSH BUTTON was well placed early, angled off the rail into the turn then angled to the inside in the stretch and drew clear, held sway in the final stages. DAKOTA DIM stalked the pace early, swung into the six path in the turn, made a bid in the stretch but did not have enough late. COVER PHOTO tracked the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn, made a bid in the stretch but hung late. LIL RICKY T TOO was unhurried early, angled off the rail into the turn and moved up in the stretch run. MIDSUMMER MYSTERY set the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and faltered late in the stretch. RED FOR THE CURE raced up close early, angled into the four path in the turn and weakened late. RARE ACTION was never a threat. REMEMBER THE NIGHT was through after a half. PRINCESS BUFFY was done early.
