AF QUACK set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn then drew away late in the stretch under a steady drive. SLICK MICK was unhurried early, angled into the four path in the turn with some stretch gain but was no match for the winner. JUST A BILL was bumped at the start, angled into the five path in the turn and moved up in the stretch run. DEVILS WAY chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and weakened late. POSH'S FAIRY TALE tracked the pace early, while on the inside into the turn and faded late. SPICEY WORLD was bumped at the start, angled into the three path in the turn and was empty in the stretch drive. POSSE COMITATUS broke out at the start and was no factor. LEFTY'S SIX was never involved. YADACAT was bumped at the start then was rushed up and eventually spent.
