DRAGONFISH well back and outside, gained a striking position through the second turn, fanned widest into the stretch, then made a steady gain and edged ahead in the final strides. OUR FRIEND HARRY well back and inside, moved up through the second turn, came three wide to bid into the stretch, then altered out for clear racing room, made a steady gain and missed in the final strides. COURT'S JOURNEY set the early pace inside, turned back a challenge through the second turn, edged ahead into the stretch and was outfinished. HIDDEN PUNCH stalked the early pace from between rivals, moved up through the second turn and bid on that path into the stretch, then weakened the final furlong. STEAMBOAT STEVE well placed and three wide, moved up to challenge through the second turn, then weakened in the drive. HOLY FEVER tracked the early pace inside, angled out to bid four wide into the stretch and faded in the drive. DREAM COMMANDER was no factor.
