CIRCUS CLOWN tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn then drove past the leader in the stretch and cleared the field late. FAMILY SONG set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and yielded late in the stretch drive. KINGWOOD chased the pace early, angled into the five path in the turn and lacked a needed rally in the stretch run. COABEY angled into the four path in the turn and moved up in the stretch. AMERICAN BEAR stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and faded late in the stretch. MY TEN DOLLARS was never involved. ONE FOR DUMAANI was done early.
