BONNIE'S EMPIRE was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn four wide, was in a strong drive in the stretch and drew away in deep stretch. SONJA'S ANGEL was allowed to settle then rallied three wide on the far turn, gained the lead in upper stretch briefly then was in a strong drive but hung in late stretch. LADY DURLYN was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn while three wide, was blocked in upper stretch making a bid then raced evenly in late stretch. CLEAR DANGER was allowed to settle while inside, saved ground on the far turn then made a bid two wide in upper stretch but came up empty in late stretch. MISS GIGI was well placed while racing two wide, made a bid on the far turn then faltered in the stretch drive. FIGHTING XENA was unhurried early while racing on the inside and was no threat. STREET LINE set the pace while inside, was used up and gave way in the stretch drive.
