Footnotes

A DASH OF GREY pressed the pace, angled three wide into the turn, took over in stretch, was driving to the finish. POSITIVE CASH FLOW stalked the leader from the outside, angled four wide in the turn and held place. SEARLES well placed early, angled three wide in the turn and just missed place. FAITH IN GOD back early, fanned five wide in the turn and moved up. GIVE ME A LITE had no early speed, swung six wide in the turn with a mild bid. FLORIDA'S QUIXOTE raced evenly from inside with no late response when needed. BOOMING BUCKAROO set the early pace, off the rail in the turn and gave way in the drive. ETHER raced up close early, angled four wide in the turn and faded thereafter. MOR OR LESS void of early speed, angled three wide in the turn while no factor. BOOTSMADDEFORRUNNIN always outrun.
