BOOT SCOOTIN BABY chased the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn, edged clear late in the stretch from the inside. CHEESEBURGER CAT tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn, made a bid in the stretch but weakened late. STRAIGHT SCOOTER was well placed early, angled into the five path in the turn and flattened out in the stretch drive. HIGH SKY set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and gave way in the stretch run. WAKI TRICK stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and faded late. HEY BOB was back early, angled into the three path in the turn and moved up in the stretch. HUSTLIN JOE angled into the three path in the turn while no threat. JUST WATCHME SARAH was never a factor. STEEL RED was done early.
