MAX'S PICTURE THAT sprinted to a clear lead from the gate, was never challenged, drew off in the lane and was ridden out to be well clear. BULBRUSH chased the winner from the gate, could not head that one but stayed on to have a mild gain and hold the place safe. SWEET LITTLE DIXIE tracked the winner on the rail, then ran evenly through the stretch. LOGAN TOWNSHIP well back and between rivals, fanned four wide to bid into the stretch, closed fast in the lane to get a share and be best of the rest. ZYGLOW steadied along in the early going, gained contention through the turn, then had no stretch rally. SPURTABILITY lost ground. NOBLE AMBASSADOR was no factor. BATES CITY showed little.
