TOUR THE TOWN set the pace early, while on the inside into the far turn then remained clear in the stretch and held sway in the final stages. SPACE OF TIME stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn and flattened out late in the stretch run. ROSSINI'S MUSE tracked the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and weakened late. WEB WE WEAVE was well placed early, swung into the six path in the far turn with no late gain in the stretch. RUBY'S MAGIC SPELL angled into the three path in the far turn while no threat. REMEMBER THE NIGHT chased the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and faded late in the stretch drive. FORBID THE QUEEN was done early. NOT ENUFF JUSTICE stumbled at the start and was no factor.
