EVENLY mid pack and inside, moved up through the turn, angled out and bid five wide into the stretch, then made a steady gain and got up in the final strides. LION'S TERMS stalked the early pace outside, came three wide to bid into the stretch, gained a clear lead and was outfinished. BASIN BANANNIE well placed and outside, moved to a striking position through the turn, bid four wide into the stretch and flattened out. SAILORS PASTTIME well back and outside, looped rivals three wide through the turn, fanned widest to bid into the stretch, drifted in and had a mild gain. DANCING LYDIA ran evenly. ACCORDING TO PLAN set the early pace inside and faded in the drive. FORWARD SAIL was no factor, inside. OPTIMISTIC SREVA was never involved, off the rail. CLEAR CUT was a brief factor. SMELL THE ROSES well placed and between rivals, had no rally.
