GRAN LIONESS well placed and outside, looped rivals three wide through the turn, bid on that path into the stretch, drew off and was kept to the task. WINKING STAR set the early pace inside, drifted out slightly into the stretch, drifted back in in the lane and weakened. DR. DIAMONDS PRIZE well placed and three wide, angled in quickly into the turn, moved up and got through inside of rivals into the stretch and lacked the final kick needed. MY LUCKY FORTUNE mid pack and on the rail, moved up on the two path through the turn, then lost ground in the lane. MARCH MARY ran evenly. MARIA'S LUCK improved her position. REFLATE THE BUBBLE stalked the early pace outside while pulling and faded after a half. VICTORIA DRIVE was no factor. RUTH AND NEVA showed little. SUNSET BELLE was never involved.
