Footnotes

OLD SMOOTHIE dueled early, angled off the rail into the far turn then drew away late in the stretch under a steady drive. BOLD SPIRIT stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn, made a bid in the stretch but weakened late. SIR JIM tracked the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and lacked a late bid in the stretch drive. BUDFREE dueled early, angled into the three path in the far turn and faded late. MARDI GRAS PARTY angled off the rail into the far turn while no threat. RAPID SURVIVOR angled off the rail into the far turn and moved up in the stretch. SGT MAJOR SCHLOSKY was never a factor. RIVER ROAN was done early. MAJOR POINT had early speed then retreated.
