SECEY SUSIE stalked the pace, drew off, won ridden out. VIGGY'S MISSY was well placed, rallied, was no match for winner, but was second best. JUNGLE BONNET was void of early speed, had a late rally, was gaining. FLUFF AND FOLD had good early speed inside, gave way mid stretch. THORN MUSIC stalked the pace, ran evenly, no rally. CRYPTOPHYLLIS was well placed, had no rally, no excuse. MYRNA'S MAGIC was void of early speed, passed only tiring rivals. TIGER LADY was no factor, showed little. FORTY SIX PANTHERS failed to menace, no factor. LADY STEPH showed brief speed, then stopped.
