POETRY IN MOTION with no speed remained on the rail to mid stretch, came through between rivals, drew off when clear, driving. STROLLING KRIS rated inside early, angled three wide into the stretch, altered course in mid stretch for racing room, could not threaten. OPEN BANK set the pace inside, gained a clear lead at the eighth pole, weakened in the late going. MOROS FANTASTIC second flight and on the rail, drifted out through the stretch run and had no late response. ALI OLAH stalked the pace three wide, then had no rally. WINGED PHILLY angled widest for the stretch run, passed tiring rivals. LA ESCONDIDA pressed the pace outside, stopped. BLUE SAID YES stalked the pace four wide, faded. TOUR ME HONEY showed little.
