Footnotes

B. B. MANCINI tracked the pace on the rail, angled out three wide into the turn, bid on that path into the stretch, drifted in in the lane, then got up in the late stages to be clear, driving. ROCKLANE mid pack and on the rail, got through inside the early pace setter into the lane to bid, gained a short lead in mid stretch, missed. SPEEDY MEDIA close up and off the rail, gained a striking position through the turn, angled out around rivals in the stretch to have a steady gain while no threat. MY PRIVATE LAKE set the early pace on the rail, gained a clear lead through the turn, drifted out slightly into the stretch, kept position, then weakened in upper stretch. FATHER JOHN saved ground to have a mild gain in the lane. SQUEAKY RICH widest into the stretch, improved position. SAHMMY DAVIS JR had a rail trip and was no factor. MR. MINK vied for the lead on the outside, faltered. RYAN'S THUNDER showed little.
