K. O. POSH broke sharply from the gate to get a clear lead in the early going, soon was joined by rivals, dueled with A SPECIAL DELIVERY through the lane, prevailed. ALKINOOS stalked the early pace three wide, bid on that path into the stretch, dueled with the winner through the lane, hung. NAME THAT SONG bumped by a rival at the start, was well back and off the rail, angled out three wide to bid into the stretch, then got up for the show in the late going while no threat to the top two. PRINCE ELIAS rushed up to vie for the lead soon after the start, could not go with the winner into the stretch, kept on and lost the show in the final strides while tiring. DOC WEBSTER broke out to bump a rival at the start, then was never far back, fanned four wide to bid into the stretch, lacked the late response needed. DEW DETIME tracked the early pace on the rail, waited for an opening to mid stretch, was boxed, altered out when clear, lost ground. CLASSICAL RHYTHM ran evenly. MACS ROB ROY had a rail trip and was no factor. PUT UP OR was outrun. MEDICAL FIRST trailed the field.
