ROYAL LUCKEY void of speed, looped rivals three wide through the second turn, fanned widest into the stretch, then made a steady gain through the lane and drove clear in the final strides. ANTRIM COUNTY well back and off the rail, moved up quickly four wide through the second turn, bid on that path into the stretch, then made a steady gain edged ahead for the place late while no threat to the winner. APACHE STORM mid pack and inside, moved up through the second turn, came through inside of rivals into the stretch, then altered out late for clear racing room and lacked the needed late kick. MAGICAL PARK mid pack and outside, moved up to contention into the second turn, bid just outside the pace setter, duelled with that one through the lane, edged to the lead the final furlong and flattened out. SMOKEY AROMA set the early pace on the inside, duelled through the lane with a rival and weakened the final furlong. COWBOY CADILLAC passed tiring rivals. BALTIC VERSE was a brief factor. MERCURY EXPRESS was no factor. FINGER TAPPING stalked the early pace outside and was through after a half.
