GRIPEY SARAH stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn then took over command in the stretch and drew away late under a steady drive. TAPITFORPAR set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and yielded late in the stretch drive. NEED TO BELIEVE was unhurried early, angled into the four path in the turn and moved up in the stretch run. LADY LANNIS chased the pace early, while on the inside into the turn and weakened late in the stretch. STORM N ROSIE LACE angled into the five path in the turn while no threat. PUSH BUTTON was never a factor. MIS MAX was done early. ROSSINI'S MUSE showed little. MISS HEN had early speed then folded up.
