Footnotes

HONKY TONK GOLD set the pace on the rail, sprinted to a clear lead early, drew off through the stretch run on the wrong lead, driving. RESTORING HOPE stalked the early pace three wide, dropped back and angled to the rail, came through inside rivals at the quarter pole, closed well to be best of the rest. HOPEHERUNS mid pack and off the rail, angled out into the stretch, had a steady gain to be up for show. JACKS ARE LUCKY chased the pace outside, collard the lead into the stretch, could not go with that one and weakened in the drive. KUTTIN THE BREEZE ran evenly outside. SONNY STAIR void of speed on the rail, improved position. MR DON K mid pack and three wide, gained a striking position, then had no rally. HE'S CRAZY was never involved. TOUR'S BIG BIRD was no factor. SKY AND ELI mid pack and off the rail, ran greenly, faded.
