Footnotes

LAZ HAS RISEN stalked the pace three wide, bid at the quarter pole, made a steady gain through the stretch drive to gain a clear lead late, driving. AMBASSADOR JACK set the pace off the rail, angled to the rail through the turn, drifted out in the lane, was outfinished late. DOLLAR FOR DOLLAR void of early speed, gained a striking position outside, got up for the show late. SWEET LITTLE DIXIE mid pack and on the rail, ranged up, hung. MO FASTER pressed the pace outside, remained on the wrong lead through the stretch drive, weakened. FAITH IN GOD void of speed, angled four wide into the stretch, could not menace. COWBOY CONTENDER fractious in the gate, steadied into the turn, had no rally. DANNY BANANNIE fractious in the gate, was no factor.
