BURNING BUSH set the pace early, while on the inside into the turn then drew away late in the stretch under a steady drive. JACK IN THE PULPIT was bumped and squeezed early and trailed the field, angled into the three path in the turn then made a bid in the stretch but was no match. MOONSHINE STILL was unhurried early, angled into the four path in the turn and flattened out late in the stretch run. WILL'S HONEY angled into the four path in the turn and was empty in the stretch drive. BETATRON pressed the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and faded late. NIMO was done early. LUCKY CHANCE was through after a half. STAR CARSON had early speed then folded up.
