Footnotes

J. L.'S PRINCESS set the pace racing off the rail into the turn, forged clear while dropping inside racing into upper stretch, then just held the late challenge of RUNAWAY DO under stout pressure. The latter stumbled at the break, was settled on the inside to the turn, swung out five wide midway through that bend, continued well to the end and just missed. I'LL BE PRAISED shifted out, bumped NATALIE'S SECRET at the start, settled on the backstretch, made steady progress four wide to gain contention, gradually drew on terms with the pacesetter but was outfinished in the final stages. DEBUTANTE DANCER tracked just off the pacesetter to the turn, was caught in tight quarters entering the bend and couldn't produce a closing response. PRETTY LILLY tracked the pacesetter along the rail to the bend, briefly lacked room on the turn, then faded in mid stretch. CERTAIN PHONE stalked the pace on the inside, was forced to steady off rivals entering the turn, continued in traffic to the lane and never regained a contending position. NATALIE'S SECRET, bumped at the start, recovered quickly to chase the pace five wide into the turn and soon gave way. MYSTIC POINTE was under pressure to advance, chased the pace four wide on the backstretch and was soon finished.
