Footnotes

PICTURE THIS TUX showed the most speed to make the pace on a short lead out from the rail, edged clear through the turn then dug in through the stretch to hold ISLE OF TUNES safe by a narrowing margin. ISLE OF TUNES pressed the pace from along the inside through the turn, angled out in the lane and responded to be slowly getting to the winner late. DARBY CREEK HONEY pressed the pace three wide through the turn to midstretch and came up empty in the final furlong. FENTER AGAIN showed early foot while four wide to the turn, angled in turning into the stretch but could not threaten the top ones. WILD CHATTER moved up three to four wide through the turn then swung widest through the stretch to improve position while not a threat. BEAUS MUSIC prompted the pace while five deep going to the turn, remained a close up factor while four wide on the bend and tired. GOLD IDEA was no threat racing four wide. YOU SAID HONKYTONK angled out heading up the backstretch to be hung six wide through the turn into the stretch. VINDICATED LADY was six deep to the turn and tired. SMALL TOWN LADY was seven deep going to the turn, remained five wide through the bend and gave way.
