STAKES Indiana Breeders' Cup Oaks Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$100 each which shall accompany the nomination, \$200 to pass the entry box and an additional \$200 to start with \$350,000 added by Hoosier Park and an additional \$50,000 from the Breeders' Cup Fund for Cup Eligibles only. The host association's money to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Breeders' Cup fund money also correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup Fund money not awarded reverts back to the fund. Weight: 121 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 at one mile or over in 2005, 3 lbs. ; of \$30,000 at such a distance in 2005, 5 lbs.; of three races other than maiden or claiming, 7 lbs.; of two such races, 9 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing (72 Hour Closing). High weights preferred. Trophy given to the winning owner by Breeders' Cup Limited.

FLYING GLITTER was on the pace racing about the two and three path while pressured from her inside by MISS MATCHED, gamely dispatched that rival entering the lane to kick clear then held EYES ON EDDY safe late while drifting in and out a bit in the closing sixteenth. EYES ON EDDY stalked the pace racing three and four wide while never far back, came five wide into the stretch with her bid and slowly closed but could not run down the winner. MISS MATCHED was hustled up inside FLYING GLITTER to force the issue into the first turn, remained along the rail to bid repeatedly heading up the backstretch and through the far turn, took back and angled out in midstretch then weakened and lost the place late. R LADY JOY stalked the pace racing three to four wide in good position, moved to challenge into the far turn then could not mount a final closing response. PUSSYCAT DOLL tracked the leaders from three wide, moved to challenge midway up the backstretch then weakened in the far turn. RIMROC GOLD lacked early speed to drop well off the pace then closed a gap through the lane but was not a threat.
