STRAIGHT SCOOTER was unhurried early, angled off the rail into the turn then rallied in the stretch and angled to the inside then drove past the leader in the final stages. HAARMAN set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn then remained clear in the stretch but yielded late in the drive. UNLOOSEMED BIT was back early, while on the inside into the turn with a late gain in the stretch but was not enough late. FLAT OUT RICH was well placed early, angled into the five path in the turn with a mild gain in the stretch run. CHOW WAGON was reserved early, angled into the five path in the turn with some gain in the stretch. WALLSTREET CHARLIE chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and faded late. PROHIBITIVE was done early. CHECK IN ADVANCE had early speed then retreated. MOTION ME ON was through after a half. VERY CLEAR was always outrun.
