Footnotes

UMMA UMMA shared the early lead just off the inside, had the rail on the bend, floated out some entering the stretch, moved clear under a drive and held off JOEFINE under steady urging. JOEFINE rated between horses, angled in entering the turn, commenced her bid, fanned out to path three for the stretch run, closed well and was getting to the winner late. DEPUTY WICKETTE settled at the back, stayed off the inside, lost ground swinging to the middle of the track for the drive, drifted out under a left whip midstretch, held a straight course the last sixteenth, made up ground and caught SWEET NANAPUDDIN for third. SWEET NANAPUDDIN prominent from inside on the backstretch, backed up along the rail on the turn, came again to threaten upper stretch but could not sustain her bid in the late going. URGENCY (BRZ) forwardly placed between rivals, advanced four wide on the turn, floated out some upper stretch and finished evenly. LAMMINGS duled for the lead just outside UMMA UMMA to the stretch then flattened. IDE BE THE ONE pressed LAMMINGS from just outside, came three wide into the lane, lost her path at that point, was altered out twice trying to gain a clear path in the stretch but did not have enough left anyway. FIRST AND AWAY was a brief contender while toward the outside on the backstretch, angled in to be just off the inside on the turn and faded. A CALL FOR GERTIE was an outside factor through the early going but gave way four wide on the bend.
