Footnotes

TYME FOR WILLARD sprinted to a clear lead quickly while pulling, increased his margin and was kept to the task through the lane. CLEARANCE SALE sent from the gate to stalk the pace three wide, dueled with JOE BOYD into the stretch, shook clear of that one at the three sixteenth pole, then closed willingly to be best of the rest while no threat to the winner. STORMING WOLF mid pack and outside, looped rivals three wide through the turn, bid on that path into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. JOE BOYD tracked the pace on the inside, dueled with a rival into the stretch, then weakened in the drive. RECOGNIZE well back and inside, closed fast to late. STORM N VIEW showed little. READY TO THRILL moved up, inside. FAST HUTCH had a rail trip and was no factor. THEE HEMI had a wide trip and faltered. SANDBAGGEN brief factor, eased over wire.
