BRENT THE BANKER was well placed early, angled off the rail into the far turn then made a bid in the stretch and drew off late under a brisk drive. LATER TATER set the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and faltered late in the stretch run. SOMETHING ALARMING was unhurried early, angled into the four path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch drive. LOVE THAT TASTE angled into the three path in the far turn and faded late. DOWN 'N DUSTY angled off the rail into the far turn and improved position. ENVOYS JET was never a threat. STEPPIN AHEAD was through after a half. HAIL TO MR. LEADER had early speed then retreated. SHADOWY SLEW was done early. R C SILVER TAX was always outrun.
