STAKES Michael G. Schaefer Memorial Mile S. Listed - Thoroughbred
(PLUS UP TO 40% ITDF) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND OLDER. By subscription of \$50 each which shall accompany the nomination, \$200 to pass the entry box and an additional \$100 to start, with \$100,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last the remainder of the purse will be divided; 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Three Year Olds, 121 lbs; Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 once or \$30,000 twice at a mile or over in 2011, allowed 3 lbs; of \$30,000 at a mile or over in 2011, 5 lbs; of \$21,000 at any distance in 2011, 7 lbs. Maiden, claiming, starter and state bred races will not be considered when estimating allowances. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve starters. Should more than twelve horses pass the entry box preference will be given to (1) Graded stake winners in 2010 - 2011; (2) High Weights (Scale of weights and sex allowances considered); (3) Highest lifetime earnings.

GLENWOOD CANYON trailed the field early, angled into the four path in the far turn then rallied in the stretch with a long drive late and was up at the wire. HURRICANE IKE chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn then took over command in the stretch and drew clear but was caught at the wire. SHADOWBDANCING set the pace early, while on the inside into the far turn and faltered late in the stretch run. KARAMA stalked the pace early, while on the inside into the far turn and faded late in the stretch. OMNISCIENT angled into the three path in the far turn and lacked a late bid in the stretch drive. GOOD LORD was through after a half. I'M SO LUCKY tracked the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and was empty in the stretch. SLICK PARDONED ME hopped at the start then rushed up and was eventually spent. DUE TO A TIMER MALFUNCTION THE RACE WAS RETIMED AND A NEW FINAL TIME ESTABLISHED.
