STAKES Hoosier Breeders Sophomore S. Black Type - Thoroughbred
(INCLUDES UP TO \$84,000 ITDF) FOR REGISTERED INDIANA BRED THREE YEAR OLDS. COLTS AND GELDINGS PREFERRED. By subscription of \$50 each which shall accompany the nomination, \$200 to pass the entry box and an additional \$100 to start, with \$84,000 added. After paying 1% to owners of horses finishing sixth through last, the remaining purse will be divided; 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 124 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes allowed 3 lbs; of two races other than maiden or claiming, 5 lbs; of a race other than maiden or claiming, 7 lbs; maidens, 9 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve starters. If more than twelve horses pass the entry box preference will be given to (1) Colts and Geldings (2) High Weights (3) Lifetime Earnings. The entry fee will be refunded if a horse fails to draw into the race. Two horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single interest. (S)

BELLAMY JONES set the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn then drew away late in the stretch under a steady drive. PASS THE CROWN stalked the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn while no match for the winner in the stretch run. DOCTOR MARK chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and weakened late in the stretch. X PLAYBOY was unhurried early, angled into the four path in the far turn and moved up with no final gain. ELLENBERGER PARK was never a threat. NICKERS FOR CANDY angled into the five path in the far turn and improved position. H K JUNIOR was done early. SLEW CITY BOY showed little. HAM I AM was always outrun. K RUN was pulled up and walked off.
