STAKES Mari Hulman George S. Listed - Thoroughbred

(PLUS UP TO 1% ITDF) FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEAR OLDS AND OLDER. By subscription of \$50 each which shall accompany the nomination, \$200 to pass the entry box and an additional \$100 to start, with \$100,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last the remainder of the purse will be divided; 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Three Year Olds, 121 lbs; Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 once or \$30,000 twice at a mile or over in 2011, allowed 3 lbs; of \$30,000 at a mile or over in 2011, 5 lbs; of \$21,000 at any distance in 2011, 7 lbs. Maiden, claiming, starter and state bred races will not be considered when estimating allowances. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve starters. Should more than twelve horses pass the entry box preference will be given to (1) Graded stake winners in 2010 - 2011; (2) High Weights (Scale of weights and sex allowances considered); (3) Highest lifetime earnings.

Footnotes

TAPTAM stalked the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn then took over in the stretch and drew clear slowly in the final stages. TEXAS COUNTRY DOLL set the pace early then lost the lead entering the far turn, angled off the rail inside the quarter pole and came again late in the stretch with some final gain on the winner. AFLEETING LADY broke out at the start and was unhurried early, angled off the rail into the far turn then flattened out late in the stretch run. FREEDOM STAR pressed the pace early then took over command while in the far turn, stayed on the inside around the quarter pole but weakened late in the stretch. DISTORTED LOVE was back early, while on the inside into the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but had nothing left late. DIFFERENTIATE angled into the three path in the far turn and was empty in the stretch drive. INNER GROOVE was done early. CATALINA WAY chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn and faded late in the stretch.
